Arogya Mandal would not be responsible for any accident, damage, loss or death and making compensation in any form to the representative of the bidders.

(HRAPL) shall be under no obligation to put up the lots singly or serially or in any particular manner and they reserve the right to withdraw any lots at any time during the period of Auction without assigning any reason thereof. 2.	SERVICE PROVIDER: 'HARI RAMCHANDRA AUCTIONEERS PVT. LTD.', Off. Add.- Shop No.-69, Aditya Sagun Mall, NDA Pashan Road, Bavdhan Khurd, Pune-411021. (hereinafter referred to as "HRAPL") is appointed as Service Provider by the seller to conduct e-Auctions / Online Auctions for disposal of all categories of Sugar Machinery, Surplus Items & Immovable properties with no particular interest in any of these categories being sold on behalf of the Seller.
3.	The competent Authority on who's behalf the auction sale will be conducted will appoint a committee which will supervise the auction sale and give the decision in the matter on the spot. The committee's decision will final.
4.	25% of the auction bid as Earnest Money or Full payment shall be paid in cash on the spot on the full of hammer.
5.	If, on the fall of hammer the highest bidder fails to pay Earnest Money or full payment required, the bid shall forthwith be cancelled and the lot will be re-auctioned. The auctioneer, may in consultation with committee appointed by the Competent Authority for supervising the sale, refuse to accept the bid of any person without assigning any reason whatsoever.
6.	In the event of any dispute arising as to a bid, the article will again be put up at the Highest proceeding bid. The decision of the auctioneer shall be final to all intents and purpose.
7.	The Highest auction bid will be subjected to the approval of the committee appointed by the competent authority which will supervise the auction sale and had reserve to itself the right to accept or reject the Highest bid without declaring any reason whatsoever. Such decision will be given on the spot at the time of auction.
8.	The committee reserve the right to withdraw from the sale any lot/lots advertised for sale, without assigning any reason, or rearrange the lot/lots as desired even after, publishing the catalogue by the auctioneers.
9.	The balance of the value of the bid accepted on the spot shall be paid by the auction purchaser to the joint director, within 10 days 18% interest will be charged (to be calculated on day basis) for the period not exceeding further 15 days.
10.	If the balance payment of the sale value of any lot/lots is not paid by the auction purchaser within the period stipulated in the above clause the earnest money deposited referred to in clause (2) will stand forfeited and the sale will be treated as cancelled.
11.	The stores shall be removed by the auction purchaser from the site of the auction within 15 days after full payment is made. If deliveries are not taken within 15 days, penalty of RS-50/- (Rs. Fifty only) per day will be charged till the last date of complete delivery. If the auctioned material is not removed within 90 days from the date after 15 days of making full payment, the competent authority will reserve the right to cancel the auction in which case the Earnest Money will stand forfeited and the amount of penalty for 90 days stand recoverable from the balance payment paid by the auction purchaser.
12.	Deliveries will be made only during working hours on working days. The stores shall be in every respect remain at the risk of the auction purchaser from the date of auction and the Secretary, Maharashtra Arogya Mandal shall not accept any liability for the safe custody or preservation thereof from that date.
13.	The auction purchaser shall collect copy of the delivery order from The Secretary of Maharashtra Arogya Mandal after making full payment.
14.	Should the original buyer wish to take delivery of the goods purchased through a representative, he must authorize the latter by letter of authority which shall be presented to the secretary of Maharashtra Arogya Mandal, The Secretary may at his entire discretion decline to act on any such authority unless buyer satisfies the secretary of Maharashtra Arogya Mandal that the authority is genuine. Delivery by proxy will be at purchaser's sole responsibility and risk and claim shall lie against.
15.	Re-sale will not be recognised by the Secretary of Maharashtra Arogya Mandal, who will pass the documents of sale in the name of the auction purchaser.
16.	The buyer shall be responsible for any damage done to the premises in removing the goods bought by him.
